Little Flower Catholic High School for Girls Course Selection Process Overview

A. How do students select courses for the upcoming school year?

- a. Students attended one session during the lunch periods to review the course catalog.
- b. Students received their course selection form to start mapping out their upcoming school year. We encourage the students to take this opportunity to map out their remaining time at Little Flower.
- c. Students will meet with their assigned advisor on March 1 and March 15 to review the course selection form.
- d. PowerSchool will open to the students the week on March 13. We ask that all rosters are submitted by March 26 because PowerSchool will be closed.

B. How do I know my student is taking the right courses?

- a. There are teachers recommend built into PowerSchool to help students avoid mistakes.
- b. Students will review their selections with their advisors. The course selection form based on our graduation requirements. Please review our graduation requirements document to help your planning.
- c. The course selection forms and submissions are reviewed by many different members of the Office of Academic Affairs. If any questions or concerns arise, we will be in contact with the parent/guardian to remedy any problems.

C. Are all classes guaranteed?

- a. Not all classes are guaranteed, especially elective classes. The Master Roster is created once the course selection forms are submitted and students are done their submissions on PowerSchool. All electives must have an alternative class selected in case there is a change in the schedule.

D. How many Advanced Placement (AP) classes are offered at Little Flower?

- a. Overall, we offer 10 AP classes that are in person. Through our partnership with AVLI, 14 AP courses are available for our students through this online platform. In total, 24 AP classes are offered to our students at Little Flower.
- b. All students who would like to take an AP class, must apply through the Department. Please see the AP Application form. Students who are accepted into the AP course are required to take the AP exam in May. In 2024 – 2025 school year, the AP fee is \$97 (subject to increase) for each exam. Students who qualify for a fee reduction pay \$53 for each exam.

E. Is there an add/drop period at Little Flower?

- a. The Master Roster is developed after the deadline for course selection. It is at this time that class size, teacher assignments and room distribution are determined. Total fulfillment of course requests is never possible for an entire school. The school reserves the right to cancel any course for which there is insufficient enrollment, lack of physical facilities, or staffing impossibility. A student’s alternate choices may be substituted for any requested courses that is canceled. Students should check their school email accounts regularly during the summer for course selection notifications.
- b. After July 1st until rosters are issued, it is not possible to accommodate a roster change due the Power School system. There will be a drop/add period from August 5th to August 9th, 2024. An appointment is required with the Office of Academics. A drop/add fee of \$50 will be issued.
